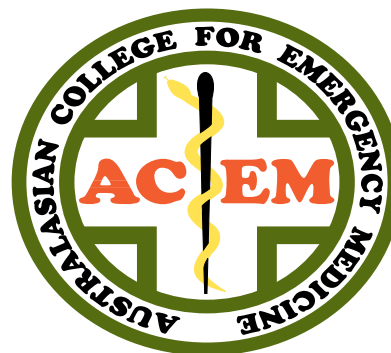

Professor Colin Graham qualified in Glasgow in 1994 and undertook higher specialist training in emergency medicine in Scotland. He moved to Hong Kong in 2004 and was appointed Professor in the Accident and Emergency Medicine Academic Unit at CUHK in 2007. He combines clinical practice in emergency medicine at the Prince of Wales Hospital with research into all aspects of emergency medicine including trauma and acute stroke. He is an active clinical teacher and he is one of the authors of the Oxford Handbook of Emergency Medicine, a popular book for emergency department staff. He has been Editor-in-Chief of the European Journal of Emergency Medicine since 2009 and he serves on the Executive Committee and Council of the European Society for Emergency Medicine.
